

The Little Pit Fishery

FISHERY RULES

1. Members fishing Club waters do so entirely at their own risk. The Club accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons or property.
2. Any member found to be in contravention of the Rules or causing damage to property shall be liable to suspension from the Club.
3. No dogs to be taken onto any property owned or leased by the Club.
4. Cars are to be parked tidily in designated places, do not block access or thoroughfares.
5. Members when fishing Club waters are responsible for the removal of all litter at their peg. Please take it home.
6. No fires of any description are permitted on Club waters.
7. No guns or air rifles to be taken onto property without permission.
8. All fish are to be returned to the water.
9. The use of live-baits is not permitted. The use of coarse fish dead-baits is not permitted. Only sea fish or trout dead baits are allowed.
10. Club membership cards and/or permits are to be produced when requested by a fellow member or Club Bailiff.
11. Club Bailiffs are empowered to confiscate the membership card if the member has been found to be in contravention of Club Rules. It will be deemed a serious breach of Club Rules to fail to surrender a membership card when so asked.
12. All anglers must not leave their tackle set up and unattended for more than one hour
13. Do not leave any rods unattended. If you wish to leave your peg then remove baited hooks from the water.
14. Portable radios are not to be played to the annoyance of other members.
15. All Carp caught are to be returned to the water as soon as possible. They are not to be retained in keep-nets or carp-sacks unless agreed by the committee.
16. No nut baits or bird seed mixes to be used on Club waters.
17. No boats to be used unless by prior agreement by the committee.
18. Night permits for the Little Pit are available for adult members only. Junior members may have a night permit if accompanied by an adult at all times.
19. Anyone on the Little Pit fishery during the hours of darkness must be in possession of a valid night permit.
20. Any member found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will have their Membership withdrawn with immediate effect.
21. No disposable containers, sweet-corn tins, luncheon meat tins etc, are to be taken onto Club Fisheries. All bait etc, is to be carried in normal bait box's etc.
22. 3 Rods may be used between 1st Oct. and 1st March.
23. The maximum amount an angler can stay in the same swim is 48 hours.
24. Unhooking mats are compulsory for specimen anglers.
